Lead Screening For students *under the age of 6 years* (Reg. 4296)

Risk Assessment questionnaire Reassess annually at doctor's office

Varicella Vaccine 2 doses of varicella vaccine;

The **first dose** received **on or after** the first birthday

The second dose no less than one month later or proof of Varicella disease with dates verified by

health care provider or laboratory evidence of Varicella immunity.

DTaP/DTP/Tdap/td Kindergarten and grades above 4 or more doses of DTP/DTaP or Td

with the <u>last dose</u> being a booster and received **on or after the** 4th

birthday.

Any Child entering 6th grade or above must show proof of receiving one dose of **Tdap**, regardless of prior immunization with DTP/DTap or TD.

Polio 4 or more doses of OPV or IPV Polio vaccine, using the same type, with

the last dose received on or after the 4th birthday.

Measles 2 doses of measles vaccine;

The first dose received on or after the first birthday,

The second dose no less than one month later

or proof of measles disease with dates verified by health care provider and if later than 2002, laboratory evidence of measles immunity.

Rubella 2 doses of rubella vaccine;

The **first** dose received **on or after** the first birthday,

the second dose no less than one month later

or laboratory evidence of rubella immunity (disease history not

acceptable)

Mumps 2 doses of mumps vaccine

The **first** dose received **on or after** the first birthday,

the second dose no less than one month later

or physician diagnosed case with dates and physician certification or

laboratory evidence of mumps immunity.

Hepatitis B All students entering the 6th grade must show proof of receiving 3 doses

of hepatitis B vaccine.

Meningitis All students entering 6^{th} grade must show proof of receiving 1 dose of

meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV) after the age of 11 years.

A physical is required for all students entering kindergarten-6th & 9th grade.

A dental exam is required for kindergarten, 2nd, and 6th grade.

A comprehensive eye examination is required for Kindergarten

Physical, dental, eye exam and all immunizations required for all students enrolling for the first time in an Illinois school.

The completed physical and dental forms need to be returned to school by August 1st, or before the first day of classes.
