Winter is always a busy time for the special education department. We are already almost halfway into the school year, and we are all looking forward to a nice Christmas vacation. But...of course, not a vacation from keeping up on our reading, writing, and math skills!

This January marks my 24th year working with students at Cross. I continue my work with students who have been identified with a specific learning disability, and, therefore, qualify for special education services. I also help create accommodation plans for students in the regular classroom setting. My Literacy Foundations Program for kindergarten through second grade helps to identify kids who need extra support in their early literacy skills. Mrs. Gina Clark, my instructional assistant, and I work together provide interventions for these kidden. With greating school less and interventions for these kiddos. With creative schedules and teachers who are flexible with their schedules, we are able to work with students both individually and in small group settings.

Did you know that students at Cross can receive speech therapy in our building? We are blessed to have Mrs. Boss, a contracted speech therapist, here two half days a week to provide speech and language services. She is amazing and a blessing to Cross, especially as the population who needs speech therapy grows each year!

As I prepare for Christmas, I remember how blessed I am to be called to this ministry to serve our loving and forgiving God each day in my work. I am thankful for colleagues that go beyond what is expected of them, giving their time and talents to teach the students with compassion. I am grateful that the Cross parents understand our mission at Cross and support our school in numerous ways. And...it fills my heart to see that our students know they are children of God and use their talents to serve Him.
